
Use and Impact of POCUS in General Practice: Prospective Observational Study

"Overall, using POCUS altered the GPs' diagnostic process and clinical decision making in nearly three out of four consultations."






- 1. Measure outer wall to outer wall =White to white
- 2. Make sure you are measuring the aorta by landmarking the spine

















